INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

- 1) Please type or print all information on the application and personal statement forms. Be sure to sign the forms in the places indicated.
- 2) Your school is responsible for submitting completed applications to The English-Speaking Union of the United States so please check with your school's Luard official for the application deadline.
- 3) Ask three (3) college professors who know your work well to submit letters of reference on your behalf to your campus Luard official. Make sure the professors have sufficient time to write your letter of reference. **One of these three professors must be in the field of your major.**
- 4) Ask your college registrar to send a copy of your official transcripts to your Luard official by the date he/she specifies. Make sure the Registrar receives the *College Registrar Form*. The registrar should not send transcripts to the English-Speaking Union of the United States.
- 5) Ask the appropriate university official at your school to sign the *Statement on Academic Credit* form and return it to your school's Luard official.
- 6) The selection committee will evaluate candidates' based a variety of criteria: academic record; extracurricular activities; community involvement; demonstrated ability to handle "culture shock"; interest in foreign affairs/cultures and knowledge of major field of study. Applicants' personal statements should be genuine and authentic.
