Understanding Korean Air's Change Policies

Fare Type Matters

The flexibility of your ticket depends on what fare class you purchased:

Economy Saver Fares:

- Changes typically allowed for a fee
- Fee varies by route and timing
- May need to pay fare difference
- Some saver fares are non-changeable

Economy Flex Fares:

- Changes allowed with reduced or no fees

Premium Fares (Business/First):

Can I change my flight online?
