- 1. Official college transcripts for all academic credits completed or attempted beyond secondary level. Campus Representatives should forward copies of the final fall grade reports for the nominated candidates to the ESU, KY Branch Scholarship Coordinator as soon as the grades are posted.
- 2. Letters of recommendation from two members of the faculty at your home institution.
- 3. A two to three-page (double-spaced, single sided) personal statement indicating your intellectual goals in applying for the ESU TLab-UK Scholarship with a description of the specific course of study you would like to pursue through the programs offered as a part of the ESU TLab-UK (consult https://www.esuus.org/what-we-do/teachers-learning-abroad/ for more information), and your area-specific qualifications to undertake the program of study you have selected. Your statement should give evidence of your writing abilities, maturity, motivation, and your adaptability to new circumstances. How do your objectives for studying abroad compare to the ESU's mission and objectives? How will you apply the personal experience of British culture upon your return home? You will be required to write papers which will be graded by the institution you select. Your statement should reflect your ability and willingness to write such papers.

Campus Representatives: Please include 6 copies PLUS the original of each student's application, personal essay, letters of recommendation, and official college transcript. Therefore, a **TOTAL of 7 sets** of applications (1 original and 6 copies) should be included in a complete application packet.

Please note that universities in the United Kingdom do not always have access for individuals with physical disabilities.

All essays and letters of recommendation MUST be printed on single-sided paper. NO double-sided personal documents will be accepted in the application process.
